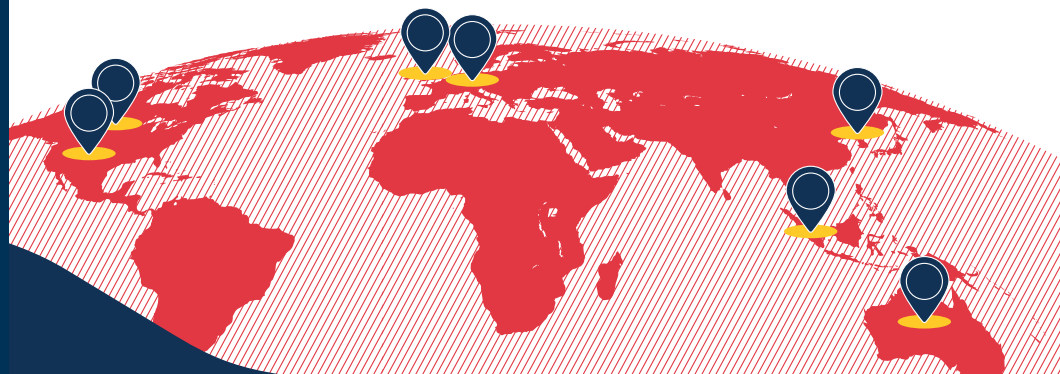

# IBDP FAST FACTS

MAY 2023 EXAMINATION SERIES

- 16<sup>th</sup> IBDP cohort to graduate, and second largest cohort of 107 graduates
- BIS students awarded 36.7 average points compared to the world average of 30.2
- 3 students awarded the maximum score of 45 points putting them in the top 1% of students worldwide
- A further 8 students received a near perfect score of 44 points
- 37.4% of students awarded 40 points or more
- 72% of students achieved 35 or more points. In total, 86% of our IBDP graduates scored above the world average
- 13.1% of our students were awarded a Bilingual Diploma
- BIS IB Diploma pass rate was 98.1%

# IGCSE FAST FACTS

MAY 2023 EXAMINATION SERIES

- Second largest IGCSE cohort of 130 students
- 98.2% of grades awarded were A\*-C
- 70.2% of grades achieved were A\*/A
- 19.2% of the year group, achieved A\*/A in all subjects
- 35.4% of the year group, achieved A\*/A in at least 8 subjects
- 51 students were entered in to their IGCSE Extended Mathematics one year early and whilst in Year 10 (Grade 9) with 98% achieving A\*/A
- 98.5% of all students achieved 5 A\*-C grades

## Curriculum and Results

BIS HCMC delivers a curriculum that is both stimulating and challenging, providing a broad and balanced education that is essential in preparing students for the future.

### EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE - YEAR 6 (GRADE 5)

- National Curriculum of England and International Primary Curriculum (IPC).

### YEAR 7 (GRADE 6) - YEAR 9 (GRADE 8)

- National Curriculum of England - Key Stage 3

### YEARS 10 AND 11 (GRADES 9 & 10)

- Cambridge IGCSE for all subjects except English, where we follow Oxford AQA.
- Grades are awarded by Cambridge International Examinations on the scale A\* - G in all subjects except for English which are awarded 9-1.

### YEARS 12 AND 13 (GRADES 11 & 12)

- IB Diploma Programme (IBDP).

IBDP students study 6 subjects, 3 at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL). Final results in each subject are awarded according to the 7-point grading scale as stated by the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO), in which 1 is the lowest and 7 is the highest.

A maximum of 3 points is awarded for successful completion of the DP core subjects of Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and Extended Essay (EE), each of which is graded from A - E. This makes a total of 45 points.

Full participation in, and completion of, the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) core element is also required.

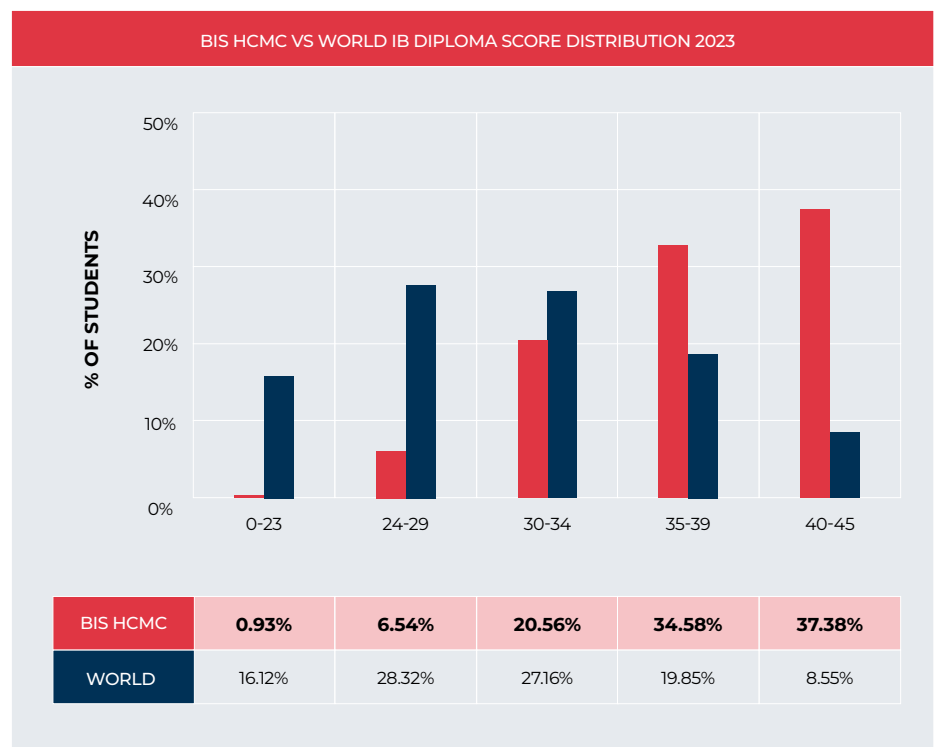
As a school we do not rank our students, calculate GPAs or convert IB points to other scales.
