Our **Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)** are an integral part of the education offered at BIS HCMC and provide our students with a broad range of learning opportunities which impact positively on many facets of their development, including academic progress. We are incredibly excited to be offering a full range of Co-Curricular Activities for Term 1. We hope to see all students take advantage of the great opportunities on offer. To ensure your child does not miss out, read for details on how to sign your child/children up.

Term 1 CCAs:

Monday 18th September to Sunday 3rd December 2023 (10 weeks)

Welcome to the Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) programme at the Junior Campus, BIS HCMC. The extensive programme on the Junior Campus is designed to extend existing learning opportunities beyond the classroom and to give all children a wider range of fun experiences that enhance the core curriculum. This booklet will help your child to choose their activities for Term 1 CCAs for the 2023-2024 academic year.

There is an extensive range of CCAs available to choose from each week at the BIS Junior Campus, and we would like to challenge and encourage students to explore some of the exciting new activities being introduced. For a full list of CCAs offered during Term 1, please see the following pages.

As part of our continued enrichment programme, we have organised clubs into 6 categories to help all children choose a variety of clubs with the aim to vary their experiences. The categories are:

Music, Arts, Languages, Sports, Technology, and Community

Clubs are divided into 2 different types:

Free clubs – offered by teachers covering a wide range of different activities.

Paid clubs – offered by outside providers, these clubs require specialist tuition, and thus fees are charged.

In addition to these selections, wider <u>sport squads</u> will be offered by the PE Department. Keep in mind that these selections will <u>not</u> count as a free club.

<u>Important:</u> Due to limited spaces, each child in Y3 to Y6 can opt for two free clubs. <u>However, if you choose only paid CCAs, you are able to choose more than two clubs as these are not offered by BIS HCMC Staff.</u>

Please note that <u>we do not guarantee that the free clubs will be approved</u> as all selections are random, so please consider a paid club when choosing options if you do not wish to miss out.



Registering your child:

How do you register your child for a club?

As an organisation, we use the SchoolsBuddy platform to share, record and allocate all aspects of the CCA programme. Details on how to access SchoolsBuddy to register your child for a club will be provided later in this booklet. For those who have used the platform before, you will find it familiar, and for those new to SchoolsBuddy, you will be making choices in no time!

You may register your child for a club from <u>Friday 18th of August at 5.00pm until Friday 25th August at 5.00pm</u>. Clubs have maximum and minimum numbers which change according to the activity, with some clubs having unlimited entry which means that anyone who applies will be accepted. See instructions on the following pages for SchoolsBuddy sign-up.

For those popular clubs that have set student limits, spaces are chosen randomly by SchoolsBuddy and those who gain a place are notified. Children who sign up for paid clubs that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list. Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough children for minimum requirements.

Paid clubs will be confirmed via email to those who have been allocated a place. Payment period will be from Wednesday 30th August 2023 to Wednesday 6th September 2023 and can be completed through online banking or by cash. Also note, if payment is not made during this time, then the place will be offered to the children who have been placed on a waiting list. Unless payment is received in full before the start date of the club, your child will not be granted a place this will be strictly enforced. Please note that all paid club payments are non-refundable (unless BIS cancel the programme), and that if a paid CCA fails to reach minimum numbers, the club will not run.

On-line Activity Selection

All activities (free and paid) need to be selected on-line. Please see following pages for instructions and you will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line SchoolsBuddy homepage.

Choosing carefully is vital as the system will not be able to make changes once CCAs have been allocated.




CCAs Sign up through Schools Buddy - Procedure

<u>Please note that the information below can only be accessed after the system goes live on Friday</u> 18th of August at 5.00pm until Friday 25th August at 5.00pm.


This system has been set up for you to select, and then track all your child's chosen activities. It can be found by going to the SchoolsBuddy website at the link below:

This will direct you to the iSAMS login page. Please login using details supplied to you by school. If a new parent, you will have received an email from school on your registered email address with the words 'New iSAMS Parent Portal Sign in' within the subject line. Use those details to set up iSAMS. If you have forgotten login details, simply click the 'Forgotten your details?' option (see green arrow).

After clicking the link, you will be directed to the login page. Do not add your email directly to this page, but instead, click on 'iSAMS (Parent)' as seen to the left.



Once logged in correctly, you will land on your SchoolsBuddy Dashboard. It is on this page that you will again be able to see the CCA Booklet and the welcome message from school. After reading, click the close button, or scroll below the message to see the sign-up options.



Under 'Available Sign-Ups', look for the block option you like.



All activities can be accessed through the drop-down arrow beside the day of the week.




Daily options can be accessed through the drop-down arrow and details such as costs involved can be seen. You then have an option of adding a preference from 1 to 5 for each club (5 maximum). All allocations are random, but the highest available selection will be offered. Reminder, we offer only two free places for this block, but up to 5 paid CCAs.



Once all selections have been made, click next, or save for later if you wish more time to consider. **Sign-up closes Friday 25**th **August at 5pm**. On the next page, review your choices and if correct, click submit to school.



When you hit Submit, you then need to acknowledge that you have fully read the terms and conditions found in the first pages of this booklet. Click okay, and then you are finished. Notification of accepted CCAs will be emailed on <u>Tuesday 29th of August</u> <u>2023</u> and the payment window for paid CCAs will be available immediately. Good luck!





CCAs Payment Procedure

Payments for those paid CCA options that your child has been accepted into can be made through online banking or cash directly to our Cashier Ms Nhi.

Payment amounts for those clubs that your child has been accepted into will be emailed to you on Tuesday 29th August; with payment available from <u>Wednesday 30th August</u> and will close on <u>Wednesday 6th September</u> at the end of the banking day. All CCAs will begin on the week beginning the <u>18th of September</u>. If payment has not been cleared by our accounts team by **Friday the 8th September**, a place will not be available.




