- After **Friday 10**th **January**, students who have signed up for an activity must commit to it for the entire term. Children cannot swap activities.

Application guidelines:

- All activities (free and paid) need to be selected online via Clipboard:
 https://portal.clipboard.app/bishanoi. Detailed log in guidelines have also been emailed to you.
- Please read the attached instructions on how to log in as parents and student login and Clipboard procedures.
- Block 2 will start on **Saturday 15 February 2025.** The activities will run through until **Saturday 14 June 2025**.
- From **Friday 10 January**, students who have signed up for an activity must commit to it for the whole of the term. Children cannot swap activities.
- All choices will be allocated with a preference-based algorithm.
- If students are absent from their activity without authorization on more than one occasion, they will be removed from the activity and their place will go to a student on the waiting list
- Activities have maximum and minimum numbers, which vary according to the activity. Once the maximum number of children has been reached, the activity will be 'closed'
- Children who sign up for activities that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list. Activities may be cancelled if the total number of participants does not meet the required minimum.

Important Information on Paid Activities

- Confirmation: We'll email you if your child secures a spot in a paid activity.
- **Payment**: Please wait for our confirmation email before making any payments. This email will detail the total amount due, factoring in any existing deposits.
- **Adjustments for Year 4-6**: For students in Years 4 to 6 attending residential trips during this block, we'll adjust fees based on the sessions missed.
- **Agreement**: By selecting a paid activity and completing the payment in Block 2, you accept the school's liability waiver and commit to paying the required fee.

Late Bus Service

What is the late bus service?

The late bus service is available for students participating in CCAs that finish after 4:10 pm on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Additionally, there is a potential for a paid late bus service to run on Tuesdays and Fridays, depending on levels of interest, costings, and route planning.

How does the late bus service work?

- **Regular Service:** If you have paid for the regular bus service, this includes morning pick-up and departure from school at 3:15 pm.
- Late Bus: A complimentary late bus at 4:15 pm is available on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays for students on the regular school bus service. Our aim is to ensure all students can access this service, but it is subject to availability and route planning. If availability is limited, we may need to adjust your child's selected CCA to align with bus routes.
- **Paid Late Bus:** there is a potential for a paid late bus service to run on Tuesdays and Fridays, depending on levels of interest, costings, and route planning.
- **Saturday CCAs:** There is no bus service available for the Saturday CCA programme.
- **CCAs Beyond 4:15 pm:** If a CCA extends past 4:15 pm, students are expected to arrange their own transport. Details regarding these timings will be provided by the CCA leader.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What is the purpose of the CCA programme?

The CCA programme at BIS Hanoi nurtures well-rounded individuals by promoting personal growth, teamwork, and skill development. It provides students with a holistic school experience, fostering confidence, resilience, and global citizenship. Participation in at least one CCA per block is expected as part of our commitment to enrichment and our BIS Aide Memoire values.

2. How are CCAs selected, and what activities are offered?

Our CCAs are thoughtfully designed across three streams: Creative, Active, and Service. This approach ensures every student has the opportunity to explore a variety of enriching activities throughout the year, aligning with their interests and needs.

3. Who leads the CCAs, and what are their qualifications?

CCAs are led by BIS staff and external providers. All leaders are highly qualified and experienced, ensuring sessions are engaging and tailored to each child's potential while fostering a safe and supportive environment.

4. How do I register my child for CCAs?

You can access the CCA booklet and register through the Clipboard portal: https://portal.clipboard.app/bishanoi.

5. What is the cost of participating in CCAs, and are there any free options?

We offer both paid and free CCAs. Paid CCAs typically involve external providers, while many activities led by BIS staff are free of charge. Full details, including costs, are shared during the registration process and within the booklet itself.

6. What are the timings and days for CCAs, and how does the late bus service work?

CCAs run on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 3:05 pm to 4:05 pm, with a free late bus available on these days. External provider sessions are held on Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday mornings. Please refer to the late bus section for further details.



7. Can my child participate in more than one CCA? How are clashes handled?

Yes, students are encouraged to join multiple CCAs to explore diverse interests. Each child is expected to participate in at least one CCA per week. Any potential scheduling conflicts will be resolved by our BIS staff to ensure a smooth experience.

8. Are there CCAs available for all age groups?

Yes, CCAs are offered from F2 to Year 13, with age-appropriate activities available for every student. With over 100 activities on offer, there is something for everyone, fostering a broad range of interests and skills.

9. Why should I choose the CCA programme at BIS?

The CCA programme offers unparalleled opportunities for personal growth, with activities ranging from sports and music to technology and community service. Students benefit from local, national, and international experiences, building confidence, leadership skills, and a global perspective.

10. What steps are taken to ensure student safety during CCAs?

Student safety is our top priority. All activities are supervised by qualified staff or vetted external providers. Risk assessments are conducted for every activity, and our bespoke wellbeing programme ensures students feel safe, supported, and cared for at all times.
