



# Introducing our **Health Centre**

The school's Health Centre is staffed by four skilled nurses: Charlotte, Aliénor, Jasmin, and Véronique. Assisting them is Indah, the administrative assistant. Their work is overseen by highly experienced General Practitioner (GP) Dr. Christer Malmberg, who is present every Tuesday afternoon.



### Services

Our Health Centre provides comprehensive health services and wellness education to all students, including:

- Diagnosis and treatment of minor illnesses and injuries.
- Recommendations in case of epidemia, following the instructions of the SSEJ.
- Lab tests, such as blood & covid tests.
- Nutrition and weight counseling (general check twice a year for boarders).
- Referral for specialist care.
- Immunisations/vaccinations updates.
- Mental and behavioural health services in collaboration with the counseling department.
- Age-specific health education and testing.
- Chronic condition management for: asthma, diabetes, depression.
- Health coaching for: nutrition, physical activity, stress management, tobacco cessation, weight loss and more.
- For Primary students, quarterly height and weight checks, an annual visit with our school doctor for a full check-up, an annual dental check-up at school, vaccination updates, referrals to a paediatrician and specialists if necessary.



### **Medical care**

The Medical Confidentiality form is part of the annual enrolment process and is essential to ensure your child's ongoing health.

Any information given is treated with the utmost confidentiality and will be shared only where necessary with the appropriate CDL staff (Nurse, Principal, Teachers, Assistants & House Parent).

We request that all boarders fill in the medical care form which authorises the school to act "in loco parentis" for the emergency care of a student and in communication with the medical staff and house parents.

### **Chronic disease**

In situations involving chronic illnesses that necessitate emergency or regular treatment at school, the Health Care Centre will request a medical report containing the doctor's instructions and the medical prescription record. If feasible, parents are asked to provide a translated version in English or French. Your child's treatment will be securely stored at the Health Centre or handed over to the house parents.

### **Recommended vaccinations**

The Health Centre recommends you vaccinate your child accordingly to the Swiss vaccination schedule.

Parents are kindly requested to provide a copy of their child's vaccination record, preferably with a translation in English or French, if available.

### **Medical appointments for boarders**

For boarders, the Health Centre will organise all medical appointments, provide transport, and keep sick students in the rest room of the Health Centre during the day.

### **School insurance for boarders**

All external medical appointments for boarders should be booked through the Health Centre.





#### **Our insurance covers:**

- All medical appointments, diagnoses, and examination fees.
- The vast majority of prescribed medication- anything not covered is billed directly to parents.
- Hospitalisation in a semi-private room.
- 6 appointments with a psychologist or psychiatrist.

Glasses, lenses, dental, and orthodontic care are not covered.

Cover is provided worldwide, excluding the USA. However, please note that elective treatments outside of Switzerland are not covered.
