What is Global Campus?

Global Campus is Nord Anglia's student facing online learning platform. It is a safe, password-protected space only for Nord Anglia students. It provides activities, challenges and competitions your child can engage with which connect them to other Nord Anglia students around the world.

How will my child form connections on Global Campus?

Global Campus provides opportunities for your child to connect with their community, with the world, with global expertise and with themselves.

In practice, this could look like reading a Pen Pal's perspective, being aware of International Days of Note celebrated around the world, engaging with a Q&A with Juilliard artists and MIT experts, or doing mindfulness.

How do I log my child onto Global Campus?


1. Go to <https://globalcampus.nae.school/> or search 'Nord Anglia Education Global Campus' using your search engine.
2. Make sure you click '**Log in with Office 365**' – this step is very important.



3. Now enter your child's **email address** and **password** making sure it is spelt correctly.
4. Your child is now logged into Global Campus and you should see their **initials** in the **top right hand corner**.

If you can't login, try amending your internet browser to be in **private** or **incognito** mode.
